4. ELIGIBILITY

4.2 Alternatively, boats ~~in the Cruising Division~~ may provide proof of compliance with ISO Standard 12217-2, Small Craft Stability and Buoyancy Assessment and Categorization, Part 2, for category "A" waters.

7. HANDICAP SYSTEMS, DIVISIONS, AND CLASSES

REVISE

7.4 Boats in Racing Division shall have an ORR-VM certificate issued by US Sailing. A copy of the certificate shall be provided to the Organizing Authority not later than May 15, 2014. ~~Both~~ Partial Measurement, Measurer Verified and Full Measurement certificates will be accepted.

7.4.1 Boats shall have freeboard, inclination and other measurements required by the ORR Rating Office done by a US Sailing qualified measurer or a Vic-Maui designated measurer. Boats shall be in ORR measurement trim for measurement. Measurement appointments shall be arranged no later than April 4, 2014. Information on measurement and measurers is available at <http://www.vicmaui.org/ratings-measurement>. Boats shall submit all required measurement data to the ORR rating office no later than April 30, 2014. Measurement by US Sailing measurers shall be at a location acceptable to the measurer. Measurement by Vic-Maui measurers will be conducted at Royal Vancouver Yacht Club's Coal Harbour Marina, unless alternative arrangements acceptable to the measurer are made.

14. RACE COMMUNICATIONS

14.2.1 Boats shall have communications capability supporting bi-directional, low-bandwidth, text-only email between the boat in any location on the course and the Organizing Authority onshore. This capability should be provided using available communications equipment such as an SSB transceiver or one of the satellite telephones.
